In these boxes, circle in the winner of each game. If the home team won circle A. If the visitors won circle B. Next to the letter you write in how many games in the set. Example if team A wins 2 straight then you mark in 2. Another example if team A wins and it went all three legs you mark in 3.

Write in all Tons and Marks in these boxes next to the name of the player who hit them. Only 6 marks or higher count. NO 5-MARKS. Only 100 or better counts for tons. A Ton-in should only be written next to the game of 301. If a player starts a game of 401 with a ton, its just a ton, not a ton-in. There was no in shot hit. Circle 9-marks and Ton-80's.

These boxes are for players names who will be playing the designated game you write them next to.

These boxes are for players outs. Mark the outs with a dot •. No slashes or 1's.

First fill in each players name who participated that night. Then fill in the amount of games they played. To determine the amount of games go back to the slots where you filled in A-2 and count. If a player went 2 legs in the first set (like Charlie above) then he has played a total of 2 games. Joan's match above went 3 legs so her total games is 3. Now fill in your tons and marks. First write in the number of tons or marks hit then write in the total amount. Example Charlie above hit one Ton and one Ton-80. So he hit 2 tons for a total of 280 or 2-280. The same applies for marks, Rosie above hit a 7-mark and a 9-mark or 2-16. Now fill in the total number of outs each player has by counting the dots next to there name. Charlie above has 2 dots so in the out column you would write 2.
